

DISABILITY MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION INFORMATION

Please read through the below information prior to making your application to us.

We welcome new members of all abilities and will do our best to help you become one of the club and shooting to the best of your ability.

However, before applying please consider the following information;

We are a non-profit making organisation. Everything that happens to keep the club functioning as we would like is done by volunteers and the club members. There are no 'paid' staff to look after the grounds, clean the club house, help organise and run competitions etc. All the work is undertaken by the members, including the juniors and their parents.

That means there is an expectation that as a member you will become involved in the work parties that are arranged to keep the field looking good, help when required at Open days or club competitions etc.

We don't have many of these, at the moment there are only 3 work party dates in a year.

Of course we understand that some people cannot do heavy work, some might not be able to walk very far etc, but there is always something that you can do to help the club run smoothly and maintain the clean, well looked after ground. Of course getting involved is also a good way to get to know other members, meet potential new friends and feel valued and part of a friendly team.

Below are further details about the 'admin' of your application, what is and isn't required. If you have any difficulties please contact one of the committee and they will help guide you through it.

Your application must include a passport sized photograph, (unless we already have one that has been previously submitted) which will be attached to your record sheet. Please ensure it is included with your application.

If there are any relevant medical facts that the club need to be aware of then you must bring these to the attention of the club at the time of membership application.

You are also reminded that any changes in medical condition that might affect your ability to shoot or your general demeanour MUST be notified to the committee at the earliest opportunity. Failure to notify could result in a suspension or even termination of your membership.

All applications are considered by the committee before any decisions are made. If there are any issues that required further explanation you may be contacted and asked to provide more details. All details provided are kept confidential with limited access available.

Membership lasts for one year and applications for membership renewal are subject to the same process.
